<b>High Level Description</b>	Increase PNR size and allow four character GFAX line numbers in the PNR display. This will increase the number of GFAX items allowed per PNR.					
<b>Impact Summary</b>	Increase NW operational efficiencies by minimizing the instances where a Worldspan PNR will become "locked" (allowing no more entries) because an agency reached the maximum PNR size limitations.

<b>Web Services (API and Messaging)</b>	For Worldspan by Travelport Web Services (API & Messaging) customers, both XML Pro and D.I.R. messages will be enhanced to increase the SSR item numbers from three to four character numerics. Users will be advised of the specific impacted nodes and fields, as well as planned test and production dates, via customer notification emails.					

## OVERVIEW

This project will increase the size of the PNR, specifically by increasing the size of the Passenger Data Area of the PNR. This increase in PNR size will allow additional GFAQ items and allow 4 character GFAQ line numbers in the PNR display.

## CUSTOMER BENEFIT

Expanding the Passenger Data Area in the PNR, where GFAQ data is stored, will significantly reduce the instances of receiving a “PNR TOO BIG” error response.
