Web Services: (API and Messaging)	For Worldspan Web Services (API & Messaging) customers, both XML Pro and D.I.R. messages will be enhanced to increase the SSR item numbers from three to four character numeric's. Users will be advised of the specific impacted nodes and fields, as well as planned test and production dates, via separate customer notification emails.

OVERVIEW

This enhancement will increase the size of the PNR, specifically by increasing the size of the Passenger Data Area of the PNR. This increase in PNR size will allow additional GFAX items and allow 4 character GFAX line numbers in the PNR display.

CUSTOMER BENEFIT

Expanding the Passenger Data Area in the PNR, where GFAX data is stored, will significantly reduce the instances of receiving a "PNR TOO BIG" error response.
