## Overview

The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has issued the Secure Flight Final Rule.

The TSA will determine if the information provided on a passenger matches a person on their "No Fly" or "Selectee" lists and will transmit results back to airlines. The new rule requires airlines (not travel agencies) to send passenger information on existing bookings 72 hours prior to departure, to be vetted against the TSA watch list in the effort to reduce the risk of a terrorist boarding a plane.

Modifications have been made to Trip Manager to collect the Full Name, Date of Birth and Gender to add into all PNRs.

A separate Product Advisory will be sent in reference the TSA changes in Traversa which are scheduled for later in May.



A new link shall be available on the left navigation bar under the Traveler Information section named "Secure Flight Information". The name of the authority "Personal Information" has been changed to "Personal Information and Secure Flight Information". The "Secure Flight Information" link will automatically be displayed for users who have the "Personal Information and Secure Flight Information" authority enabled.

A Global Profile Update will be available to turn the option on/off. Default will be set to on.

**New updated change – New Unique remark added into PNR if traveler declines info:**

**Profile Model:**

Six new fields are available in the Profile Elements list of the Profile Model. It is suggested that these new fields be added to the Profile Models so that the data is generated on traditional reservations. Updating profiles will require synchronization. REMINDER- Please synchronize companies with more than 500 profiles during off peak hours (evenings and/or weekends) to avoid slowing the Profile Manager server during normal working hours.
