Overview

Currently, at time of electronic ticket issue, a check for interline ticketing agreements is made between the Validating Carrier and the Marketing Carrier(s). In order to be compliant with industry standards, an interline agreement check will also be made between the Validating Carrier and the Operating Carrier(s) in an itinerary with a codeshare situation.

Customer Benefit

- Ensure electronic ticketing interline agreements are met between the Validating Carrier and Operating Carrier(s).
- Ensure compliance to industry standards for interline electronic ticketing.
- It is planned at a future date to include this new electronic ticketing eligibility check in Plating Carrier Logic.

Detail and Customer Examples

Interline agreements at time of electronic ticket issue will continue to be checked between the Validating Carrier and the Marketing Carrier(s). In addition to the current IET check, an IET check will be made <u>at time of electronic ticket issue</u> between the Validating Carrier and the Operating Carrier(s) in an itinerary with a codeshare situation.

The IET display for Validating Carrier Taca International (DT/IAT/DISTA) confirms TA has an electronic ticket interline agreement with Marketing Carrier(s) Northwest Airlines (NW) and Air Canada (AC).

The IET display also confirms that TA does not currently have an electronic ticket interline agreement with Operating Carrier Alaska Airlines (AS) which is marketed by Northwest Airlines (NW).



In this sample itinerary the electronic ticket agreement checks at time of ticket issue will not be met between the Validating Carrier (TA) and Operating Carrier (AS); therefore, ticket issue will be restricted with TA as the Validating Carrier.

If an attempt is made to issue an electronic ticket for an itinerary in which an interline agreement does not exist between the Validating Carrier and Operating Carrier(s) in a codeshare situation, the following existing response will be displayed to the user at time or ticket issue:

Glossary

Term	Definition
IET	Interline Electronic Ticket
Marketing Carrier	Marketing Carrier means the airline whose Airline Designator is recorded as the transporting carrier on the electronic flight/value coupon(s).
Operating Carrier	Operating Carrier means the carrier used in the codeshare situation when different from the Marketing Carrier.

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
