3 enhancements have been made to the Custom Itinerary script in Worldspan Go!

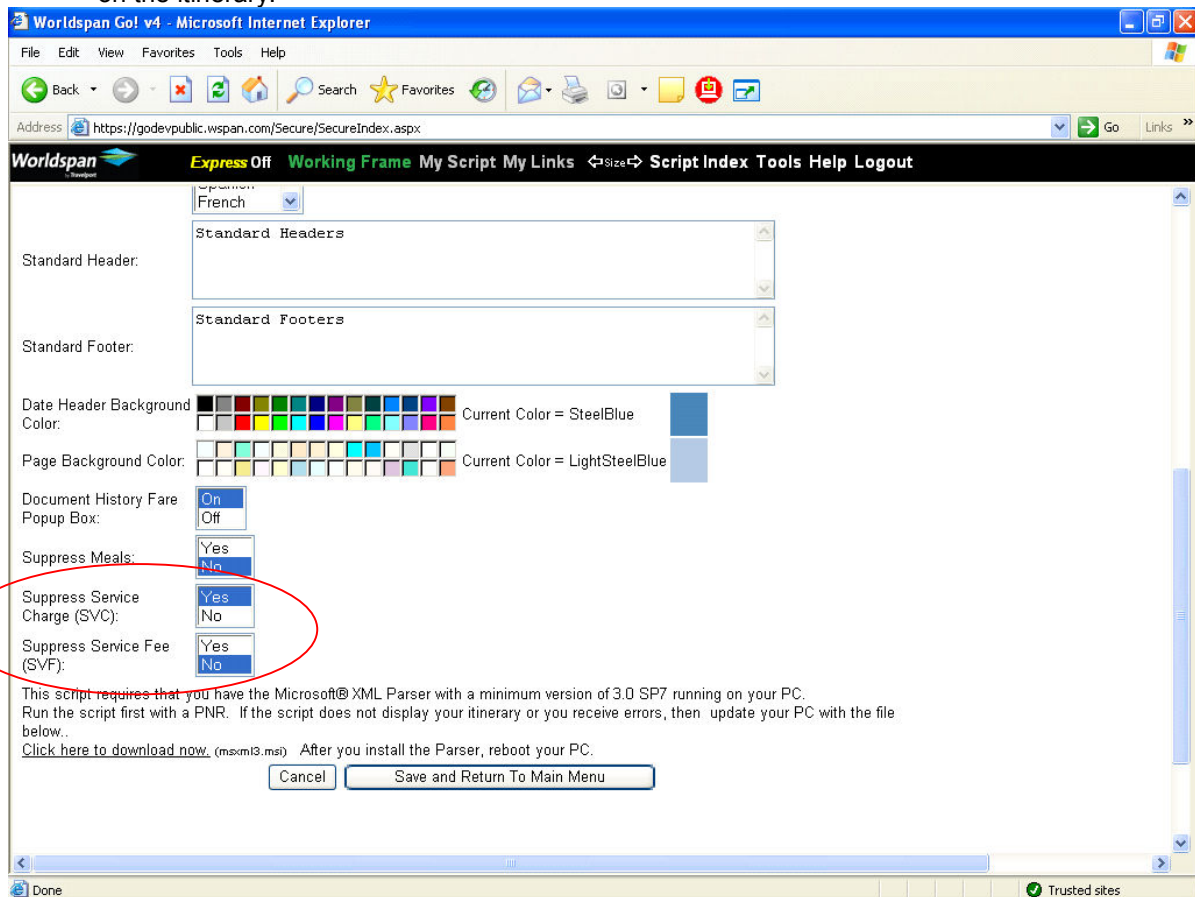
1. The ability to display or suppress service fees from displaying through a new setting

3. Once the e-mail has been sent, the date and time it was sent will be recorded in the PNR in a 5.Z remark. The PNR will auto ER to save the remark. This will be automatically done once the user hits the 'send' button on the script. The date/time used will be based on the PC settings for date format and time will be local time of the PC.
